## **Project Summary**

This project is designed to promote Non Formal Learning through which representatives of the partner organisations will share personal and professional experiences, contribute based on their competences, work collaborative, irrespective background and develop a programme which will meet the following objectives:

Objective 1: International cooperation between experienced and not experienced Organisations and individuals but also between target group, youths and youthworkers who aim to increase awareness of the importance of sustainable education and green lifestyle for a better planet

Objective 2: To increase opportunities for youths and leaders to share practice and learning on how to be improved and developed through key competences and increase understanding on the power of cooperation between communities and organisations when working with diversity using non formal learning methods.

Objective 3: To develop networking and to leave an efficient impact for the next Erasmus period on the topic of social inclusion and intercultural learning

Objective 4: To develop skills and competences but also Green awareness through campaigns and education based on NFL

### **Furthermore:**

We will try to answer the questions/themes:

(a) at what extent the current educational systems support the development of sustainable education

(b) what is the impact of new technologies and social media to our life and us as organisations and especially to our planet

(c) What is the footprint that youths can leave to the next generations

(d) To present, discuss and analyse the topics of reckless attitude of nowadays societies in regard to the environment and the planet in general

(f) what is the role of any NGO, youths and communities to the above state that appears/is developed.

The project also meets International, EU and E+ objectives because:

-secures safety and pleasant NF learning environment

-promotes the development of:

\*learning outcomes and improvement of basic key competences

\*practices for intercultural learning, equity and social inclusion

The Youth Exchange will be held in Cyprus, hosted by NECI EU and will have the following objectives:

- (a) Increase awareness on the positive impact of non formal learning and NGOs effort for a safer and healthier planet
- (b) develop youths learning to learn competence with main aim to influence youths and local community on developing opportunities for inclusion
- (c) offer safe and educative space for leaning by sharing to all participants irrespective skills and background and promote non formal learning on the base of Inclusive practices and sustainable development
- (d) explore and understand the power intercultural learning and dialogue for tackling global problems.
- (e) create tangible and intangible results that can sustain the project impact

#### **Activity Summary:**

During the YE, there will be 20 youths and 5 leaders from Cyprus, North Macedonia, Spain, Romania, Hungary and will be involved in experiential activities in Paralimni Cyprus, based on NFL approach (role plays, simulations, reflection, presentations, recreational activities, outdoor activities and environmental visits, intercultural evening). They will have sessions with experts on the topic of environment and will share real time facts about Green education from their own communities/ngos, youthworkers/countries on the topic, Through these activities and reflection on these they will realize the commonalities between cultures and people and bridge differences enhancing intercultural dialogue. Youths will have ongoing collaborative sessions for creating common partnership final products (booklet, video, keyrings, flyers).
